



## Adding a Community Solutions Hub Mini-Dashboard to Your Website

### What is a mini-dashboard?

A mini-dashboard is a widget that is embedded on a website. If a visitor to the website clicks on a mini-dashboard, they are taken to that indicator's page on the Community Solutions Hub website. A mini-dashboard allows organizations to provide a snapshot of Washington County data on their organization's website. By hosting a mini-dashboard, an organization can display data related to its mission and further community capacity towards collective impact by driving visitors to one central location for data – Community Solutions Hub.

### What options are available to customize my mini-dashboard?

#### Type of Dashboard

- Multiple Indicators – display different indicators for one location
- Multiple Comparisons – pick one indicator and display different comparisons for that location (e.g. compared to Maryland, U.S., Healthy People 2030)
- Multiple Locations – pick one indicator and show values across different zip codes/census tracts in Washington County

#### Multiple Indicator Dashboard

A mini-dashboard can feature up to thirty-six different indicators (up to six per each row and column). You have three options on how to select these indicators:

- Select randomly from all indicators on Community Solutions Hub (mini-dashboard indicators will change at random every time page is refreshed)
- Select up to three topics (Community, Economy, Education, Environmental Health, Health,) and sub-topics to choose indicators at random from (mini-dashboard indicators will change at random every time page is refreshed). See the full list [here](#) by clicking 'Filter by Topics'.
- Select hand-picked indicators from any category (these indicators will always show)

These indicators can show Washington County data, or zip code or census tract data based on your preference. You can also have a title above your mini-dashboard (e.g. Click here for more Washington County data). The size of your mini-dashboard can also be adjusted to best fit on your website.

### How do I add a mini-dashboard to my website?

Adding a mini-dashboard to your website is simple. Send us a request [here](#) with your preferences (# of indicators, which categories or indicators to select from, title). Not sure where to start? We would be happy to brainstorm the best fit for your website with you – just send us a request. We will then design the mini-dashboard and send you the HTML code to add to your website.

## Can we add more than one mini-dashboard?

You can add as many mini-dashboards as you like! If your organization focuses on different issues, you can feature a different mini-dashboard on each page (e.g., one related to nutrition on a food services page, one related to government assistance benefits on a social services page, etc.).

## How does the mini-dashboard update?

The HTML code that builds the mini-dashboard links it to the Community Solutions Hub site, so anytime the indicator is updated on the Community Solutions Hub, your mini-dashboard automatically updates.

## How much does it cost?

Community Solutions Hub provides the HTML code for mini-dashboards at no charge.
